THE SITUATION

Fishing Lake sits at 530.468 m, holding steady—45 cm below its all-time high but 57 cm above normal pool. Outflow on the Whitesand River remains flat at 12.7 m³/s, while the past five days brought 48.5 mm of rain and only 2.2 mm is forecast ahead. A wind watch notes gusts up to 57 km/h (1.2 m waves), but as a closed prairie basin the lake drains slowly over months, so no rapid change is expected.

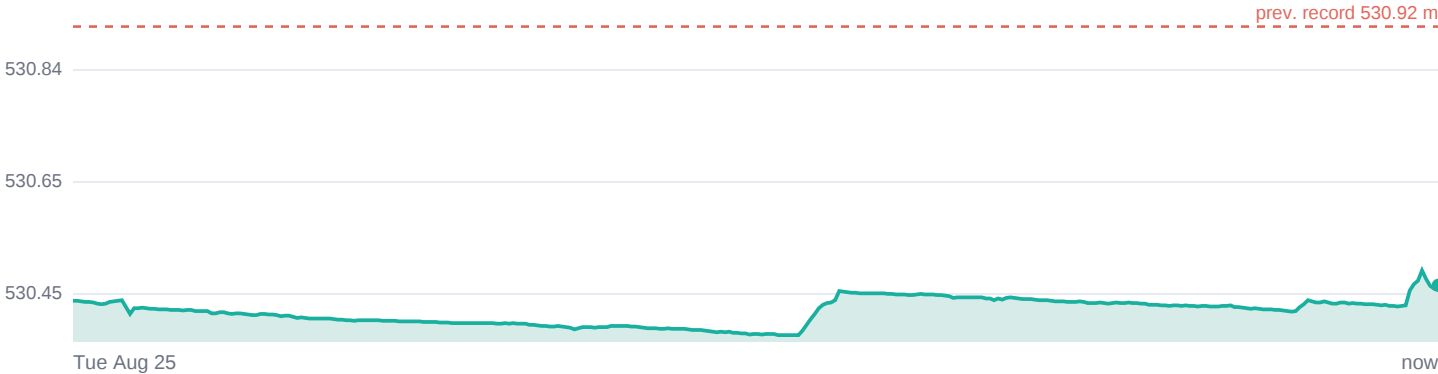
